

Number of requests submitted for extraordinary inspection surveillance:


number of cases where the Inspectorate found violation of workers' rights

number of cases where the response is pending




Regional Units of the State Labour Inspectorate that received requests for extraordinary inspection surveillance:

- The State Labour Inspectorate should sooner and more diligently treat the requests submitted for extraordinary inspection surveillance, aiming at more efficient safeguard of workers' rights.
- To enlarge and improve the transparency of the work, the State Labour Inspectorate should send all the documents of the inspection surveillance conducted (Minutes of the inspection surveillance conducted, payment order, and alike) to the submitters of the extraordinary inspection surveillance.
- The State Labour Inspectorate should improve the openness and the accessibility for the workers, by introducing functional telephone lines in all regional units and by introducing the possibility of anonymous electronic requests for raising extraordinary inspection surveillance. The cooperation should be improved of the State Labour Inspectorate with all active stakeholders in the process
