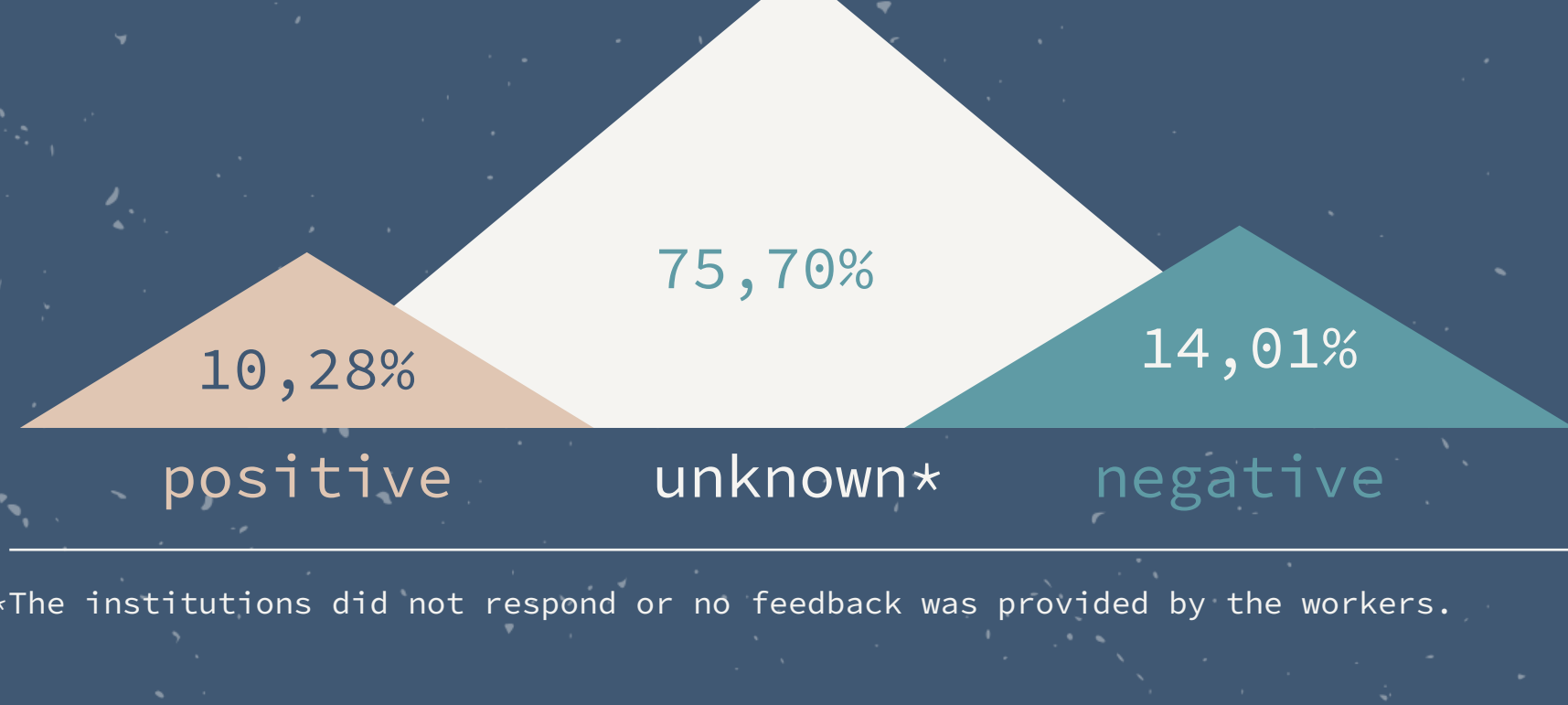

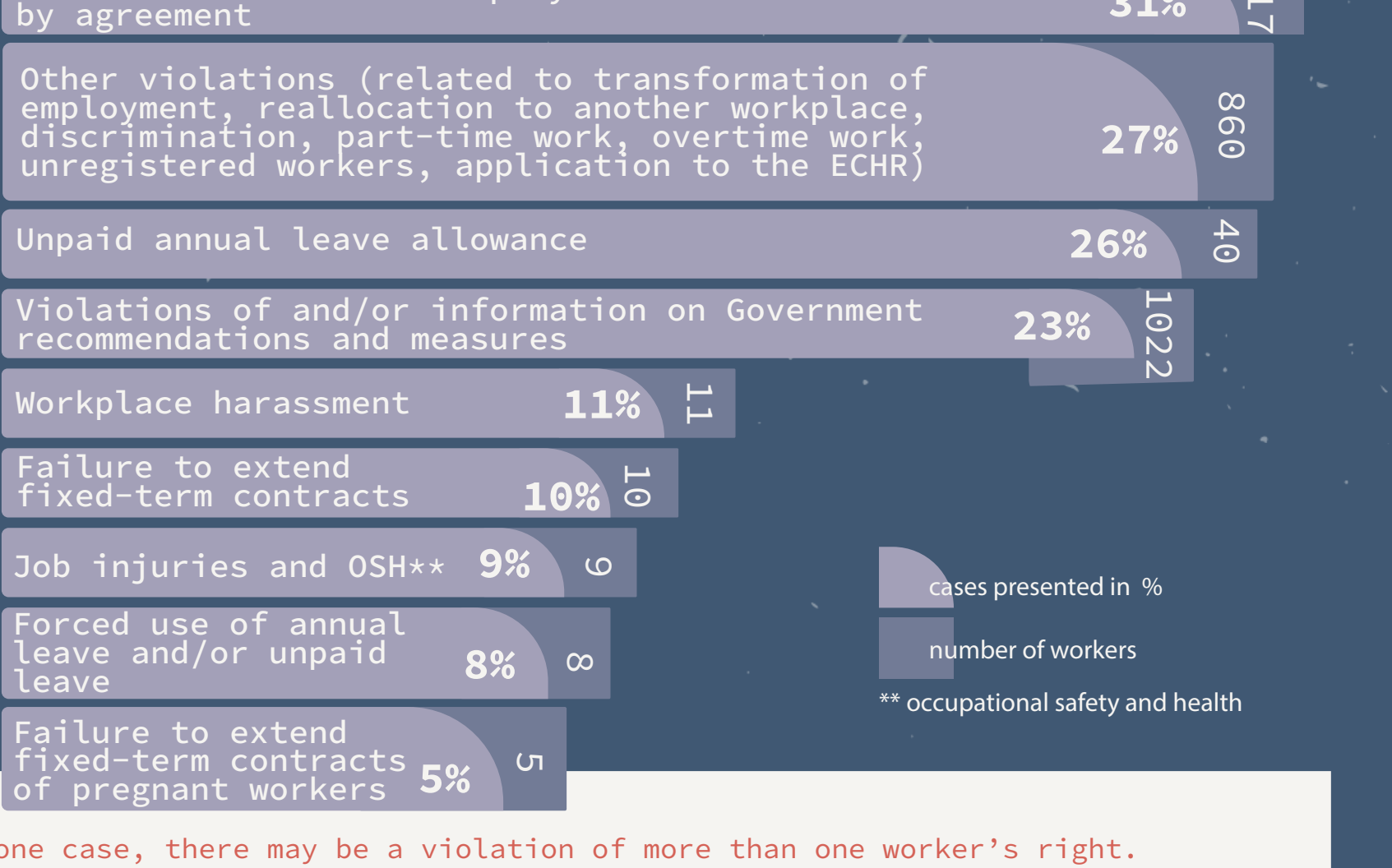

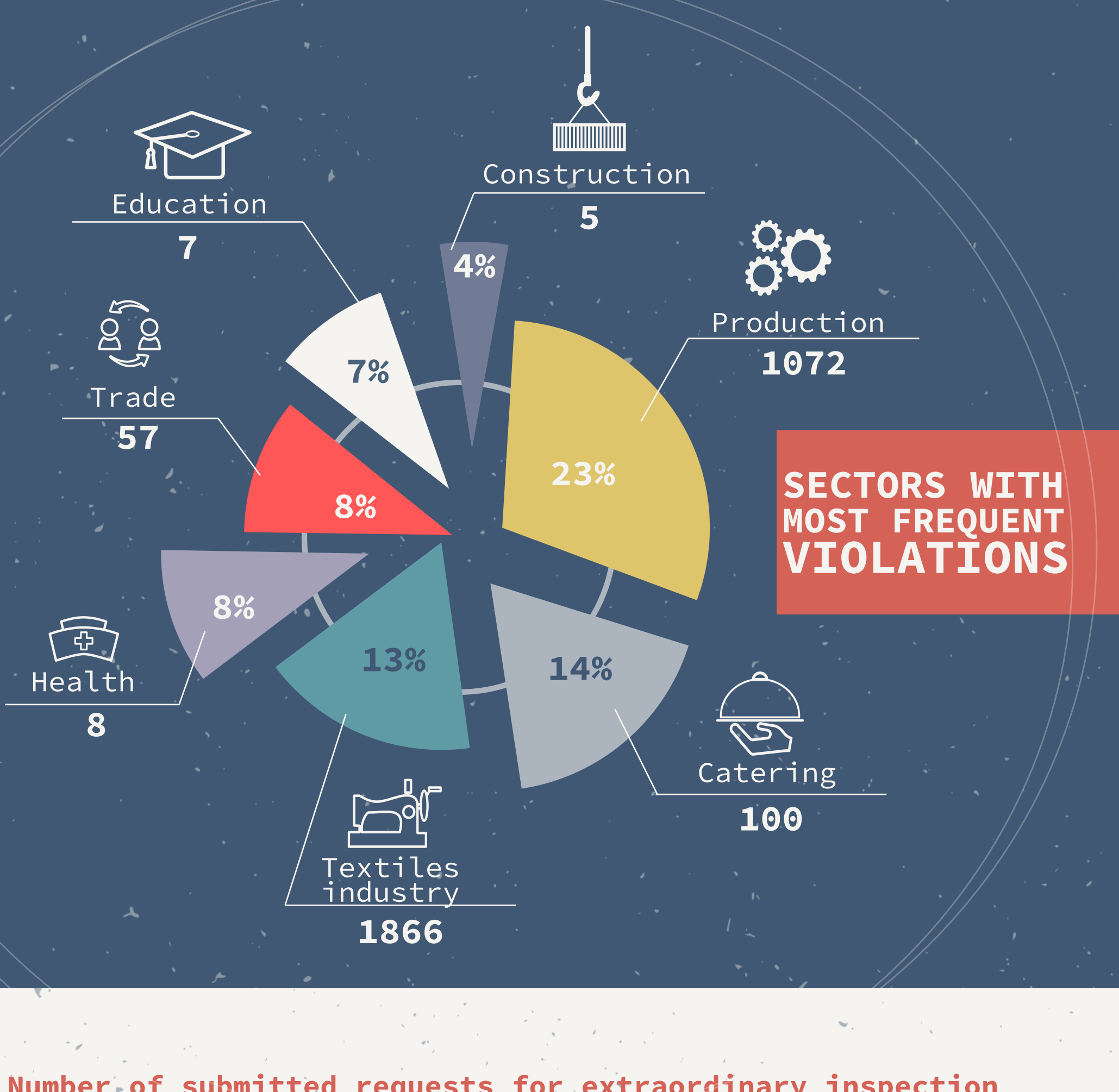

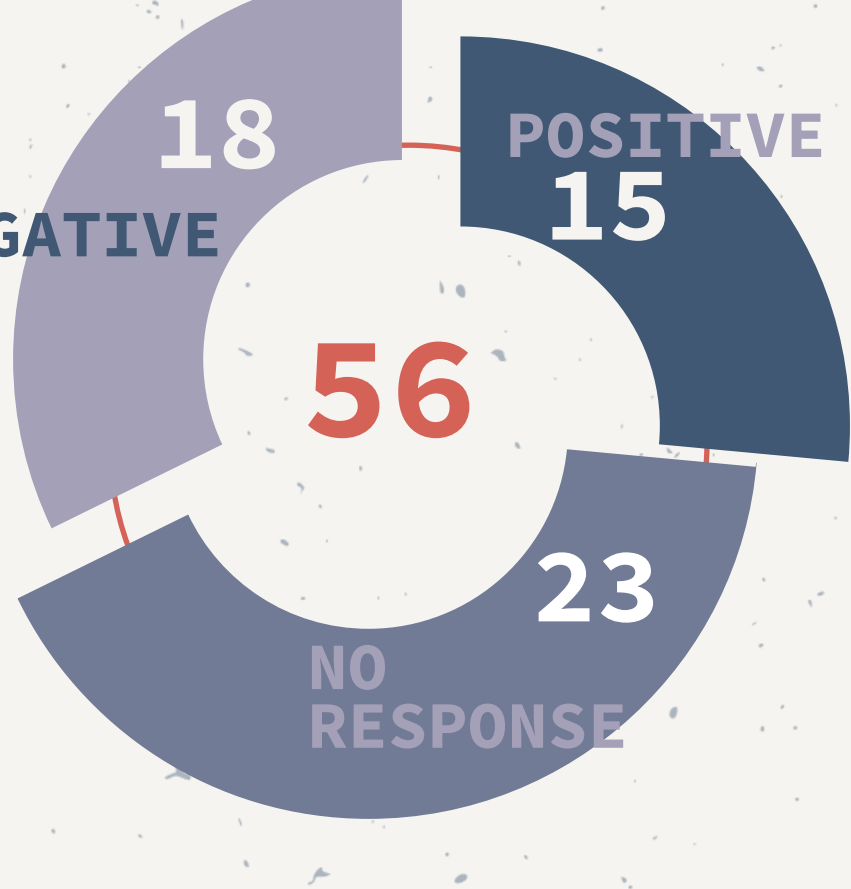

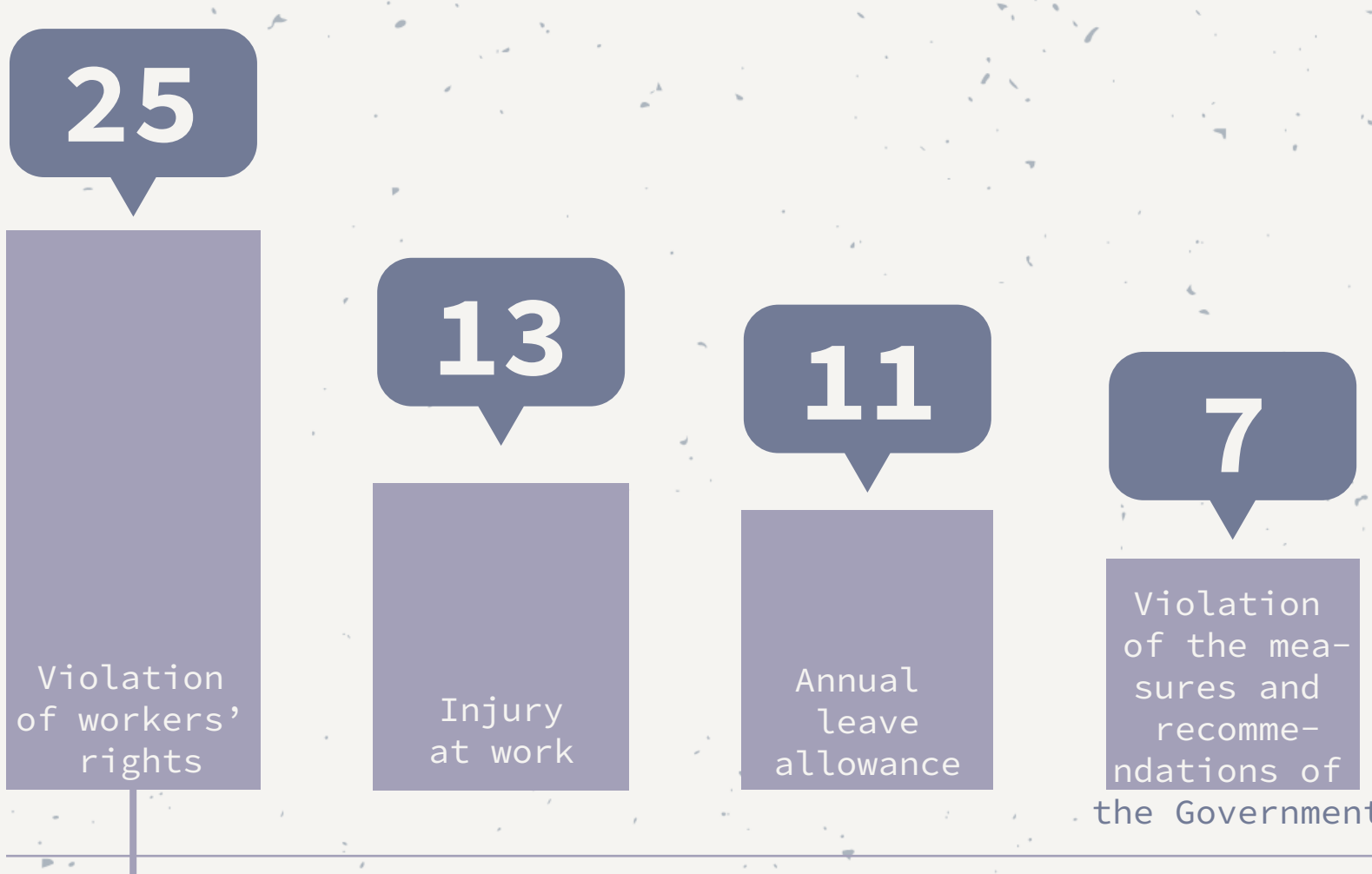
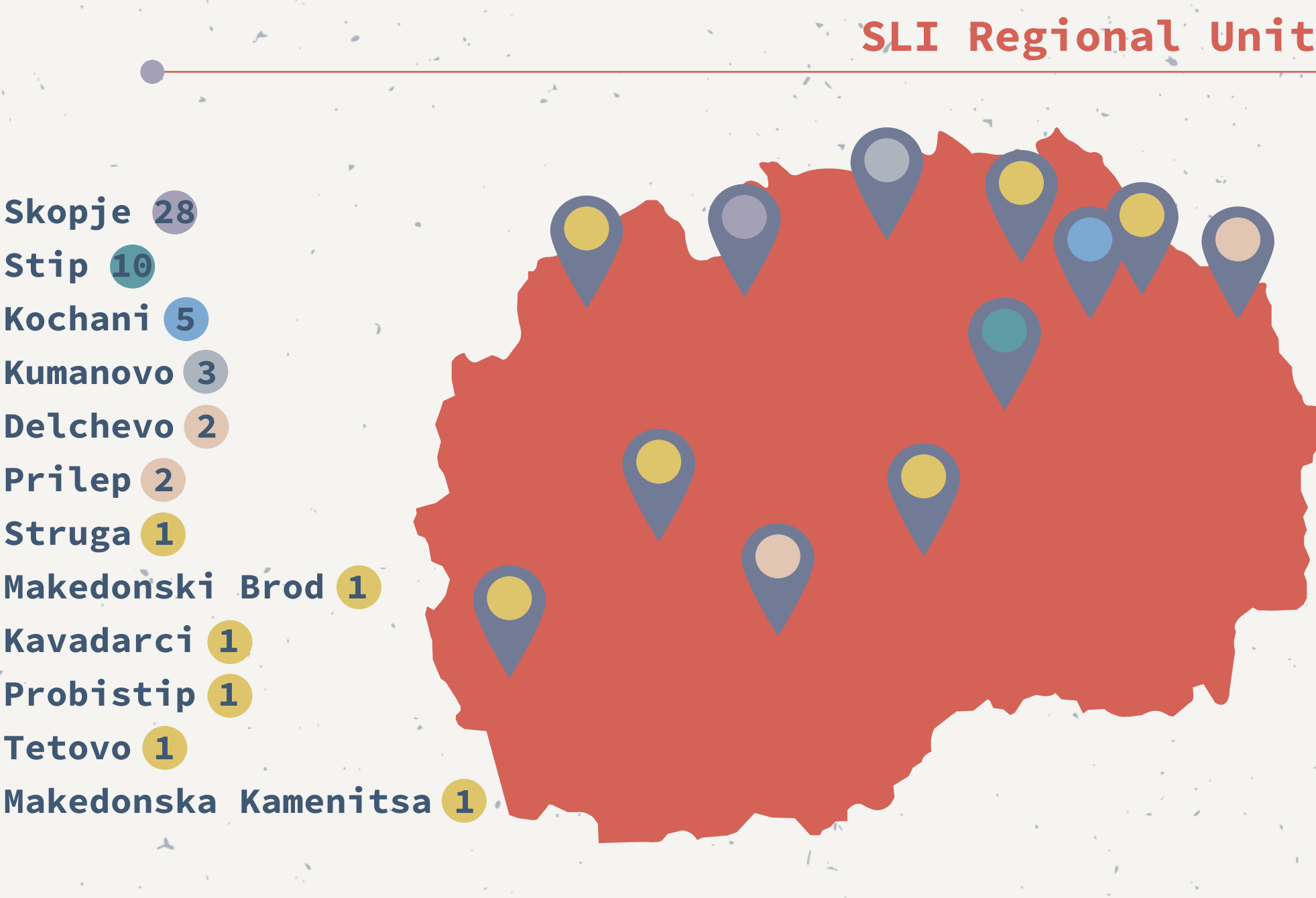
SECTORS WITH MOST FREQUENT VIOLATIONS

The State Labour Inspectorate did not submit complete documentation for the supervision performed in any case.

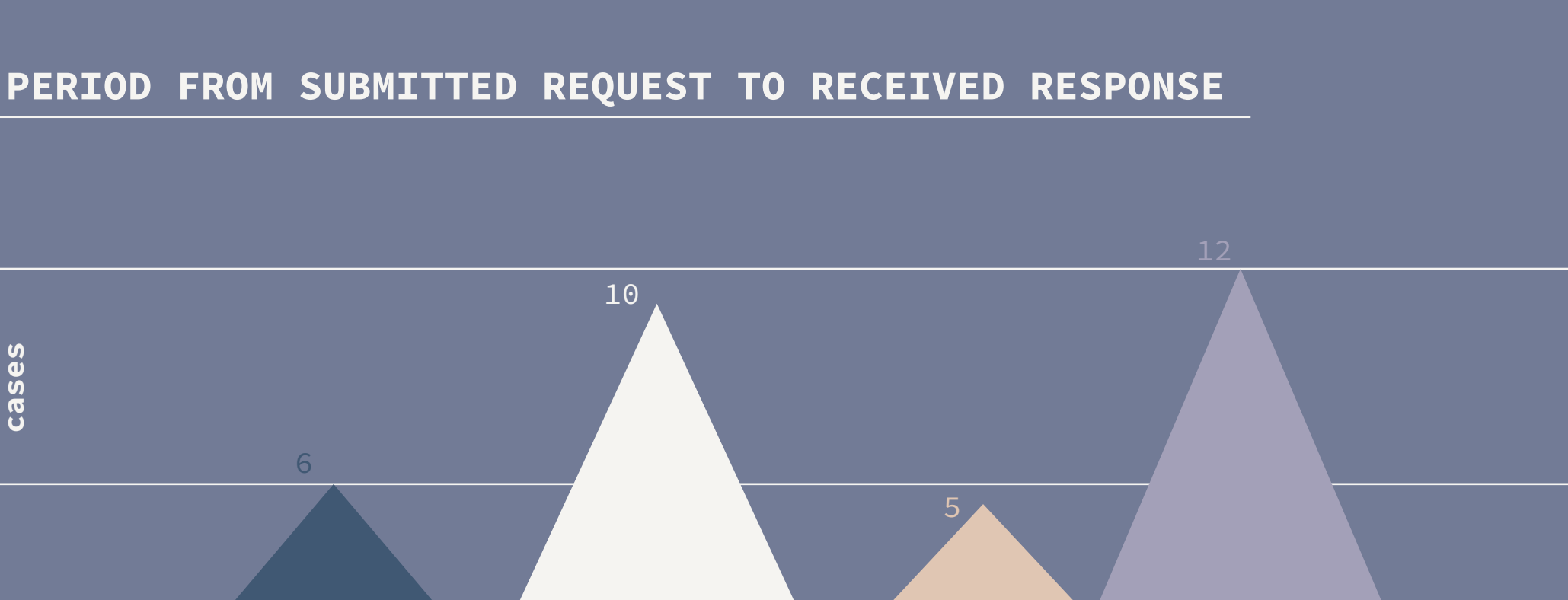
