## DURING THIS PERIOD:



Direct legal aid was provided to 14 convicts and 7 dependents



15 convicts and 9 dependents were given legal aid on the use of mechanisms for prevention of torture and inhumane treatment



During February, the second session of online counselling was held at ECI Tetovo. 11 children-dependents were acquainted with the exercise of the right to education and vocational training as well as the conditions under which children can use the right to vacation.

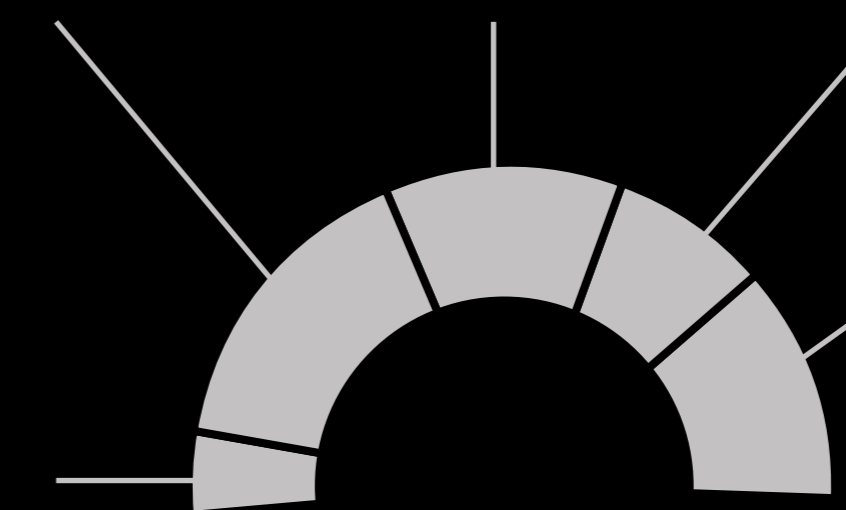

Legal advice for persons who may be included in the visitor sign-in sheet



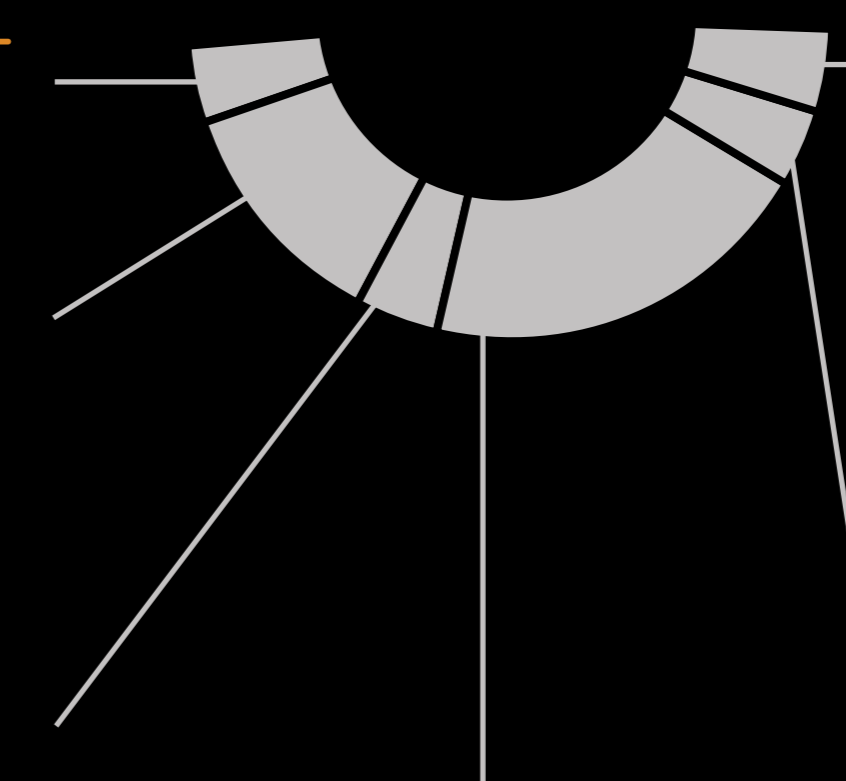
3 convicts
