 Total number of complaints submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination.





 During the monitoring period, **107** complaints were submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination.

 Number of complaints filed by women.




 Out of a total of 107 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, **42** were submitted by women.

 Complaints submitted by women belonging to any of the marginalized communities (women from rural areas, women from the LGBTI community, women who use drugs, sex workers, convicts, homeless women)


 **2** complaints were filed by women living in rural areas.




 Number of complaints filed by women from the Skopje Planning Region





 **31** complaints were submitted by women residing in the municipalities of the Skopje Planning Region.

 **30** complaints were submitted online (electronic complaint via the Commission's website or by e-mail to the Commission)

 **12** complaints in a conventional manner (mail or directly at the Commission's premises)


 Number of rejected complaints filed by women




 A total of **27** complaints filed by women were rejected.

 Number of rejected complaints from women belonging to marginalized communities



 **1** complaint from a woman living in a rural area was rejected.

 Number of complaints filed by women in which the Commission found discrimination/intersectional discrimination?



 The Commission found discrimination in **4** cases, of which **2** cases found intersectional discrimination.
