The monitoring of the actions of the KSZD to protect women from marginalized communities from discrimination was conducted by the Helsinki Committee for Human Rights within the framework of the project "Equality Now - Strengthening Marginalized Communities for Social Inclusion and Non-Discrimination", financially supported by Switzerland through Civica Mobilitas, with grants for civic engagement, which it implements in partnership with HOPS-Options for Healthy Life Skopje and the Margins Coalition.

**Monitoring period** 01.10.2024 to 31.12.2024









Total number of complaints submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination



During the monitoring period, **85** complaints were submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination

Number of complaints filed by women



Out of a total of 85 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, 28 were submitted by women

Complaints submitted by women belonging to any of the marginalized communities (women from rural areas, women from the LGBTI community. women who use drugs, sex workers, convicts, homeless women)

**3** complaints were filed by women living in rural areas

**18** complaints were submitted online (electronic complaint via the Commission)s website or by e-mail to the Commission)

10 complaints in a conventional manner (by post or directly at the Commission's premises)

Number of rejected complaints filed by women



A total of **9** complaints filed by women were rejected

**2** complaints from women living in rural areas were rejected

The Commission found discrimination in 3 cases, none of which found intersectional discrimination
