Total number of complaints submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination



During the monitoring period, **113** complaints were submitted to the Commission for Protection and Prevention of Discrimination

Number of complaints filed by women



Out of a total of 113 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, **43** were submitted by women

Complaints submitted by women belonging to any of the marginalized communities (women from rural areas, women from the LGBTI community, women who use drugs, sex workers, convicts, homeless women)

1 complaint was filed by a woman living in a rural area



Number of complaints filed by women from the Skopje Planning Region



22 complaints were submitted by women residing in the municipalities of the Skopje Planning Region

Method of submitting complaints (online or conventionally)

online post

17 complaints were submitted online (electronic complaint via the Commission's website or by e-mail to the Commission)

26 complaints were submitted conventionally (by post or directly at the Commission's premises)

Number of rejected¹ complaints filed by women



No complaints filed by women were rejected in the reporting period
