Total number of complaints submitted to the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination



During the monitoring period, **89** complaints of discrimination were filed with the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination

Number of complaints filed by women



Out of a total of 89 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, 30 were submitted by women (2 of them were submitted on behalf of a child complainant and one on behalf of another person)

Complaints submitted by women belonging to any of the marginalized communities (women from rural areas, women from the LGBTI community, women who use drugs, sex workers, convicts, homeless women)

2 complaints were submitted by women living in rural areas



Number of complaints filed by women from the Skopje Planning Region



15 complaints were submitted by women residing in the municipalities of the Skopje Planning

Method of submitting complaints (online or Method conventionally)



17 complaints were submitted online electronic complaint via the Commission's website or by e-mail to the Commission)

13 complaints were submitted in a conventional manner (postal or directly at the Commission's premises)

Number of rejected complaints filed by women



In the reporting period, the Commission adopted 14 conclusions rejecting a complaint, i.e. not taking action or stopping the procedure

Number of rejected complaints from women belonging to marginalized communities



In the reporting period, the Commission did not reject any complaints submitted by women belonging to marginalized communities, i.e. women from rural areas

Number of complaints filed by women in which the Commission found discrimination/ intersectional discrimination



Of the complaints submitted in the reporting period from 01.07.2025 to 30.09.2025. the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination has not issued an opinion establishing discrimination.
