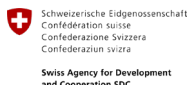
### on the actions of the CPPD regarding the protection against discrimination of women from marginalized communities

The monitoring of the actions of the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination (CPPD) regarding the protection against discrimination of women from marginalized communities was carried out within the framework of the project "Equality Now - Strengthening Marginalized Communities for Social Inclusion and Non-Discrimination". The project is implemented by the Helsinki Committee for Human Rights in partnership with HOPS - Options for Healthy Living Skopje and the Margin Coalition. The project is supported by the Government of Switzerland through Civica Mobilitas.

 During the monitoring period, **61** complaints of discrimination were submitted to the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination

 Out of a total of 61 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, **22** were submitted by women (4 of them were submitted on behalf of the complainant's child, and 1 on behalf of the complainant's sister)

 **3** complaints were submitted by women living in rural areas



 **2** complaints were submitted by women from rural areas residing in the municipalities of the Skopje Planning Region

 **9** complaints were submitted online (electronic complaint via the Commission's website or by e-mail to the Commission)

 **13** complaints were submitted in a conventional manner (postal or directly at the Commission's premises)

 In the reporting period, the Commission adopted **1** conclusion rejecting a complaint

 In the reporting period, the Commission did not reject any complaints submitted by women belonging to marginalized communities, i.e. women from rural areas.

 Of the complaints submitted in the reporting period from 01.04.2026 to 31.05.2026, the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination has not issued an opinion establishing discrimination
