### on the actions of the CPPD regarding the protection against discrimination of women from marginalized communities

The monitoring of the actions of the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination (CPPD) regarding the protection against discrimination of women from marginalized communities was carried out within the framework of the project "Equality Now - Strengthening Marginalized Communities for Social Inclusion and Non-Discrimination". The project is implemented by the Helsinki Committee for Human Rights in partnership with HOPS - Options for a Healthy Life Skopje and the Margins Coalition. The project is supported by the Government of Switzerland through Civica Mobilitas.

**Monitoring period**  
**01.01.2026 to 31.03.2026**

\*In the period from 01.01.2026 to 31.03.2026, the KSZD found discrimination in 11 cases for cases that were initiated in 2025 and whose procedure continued and ended in 2026. Of these, 4 are cases of intersectional discrimination (based on sex, gender, and in connection with pregnancy, childbirth and motherhood). In one of the cases, the KSZD found discrimination against a transgender woman residing in the Polog planning region on the basis of sex, gender and gender identity in access to goods and services.

 Total number of complaints submitted to the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination





 During the monitoring period, **97** complaints of discrimination were filed with the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination

 Number of complaints filed by women



 Out of a total of 97 complaints submitted during the monitoring period, **41** were submitted by women (2 of them were submitted on behalf of the complainant's child)


 Complaints submitted by women belonging to any of the marginalized communities (women from rural areas, women from the LGBTI community, women who use drugs, sex workers, convicts, homeless women)


 **4** complaints were submitted by women living in rural areas




 Number of complaints filed by women from the Skopje Planning Region





 **17** complaints were submitted by women residing in the municipalities of the Skopje Planning Region.

 **26** complaints were submitted online (electronic complaint via the Commission's website or by e-mail to the Commission)

 **15** complaints were submitted in a conventional manner (postal or directly at the Commission's premises)


 Number of rejected complaints filed by women




 In the reporting period, the Commission adopted **6** conclusions rejecting a complaint


 Number of rejected complaints from women belonging to marginalized communities



 In the reporting period, the Commission did not reject any complaints submitted by women belonging to marginalized communities, i.e. women from rural areas

 Number of complaints filed by women in which the Commission found discrimination/ intersectional discrimination



 Of the complaints submitted in the reporting period from 01.01.2026 to 31.03.2026, the Commission for Prevention and Protection against Discrimination has not issued an opinion establishing discrimination
